### The Campaign for Senior Jesuit Healthcare

This is a pivotal time for the Chicago-Detroit and Wisconsin Provinces of the Society of Jesus as we prepare to form a new entity — the USA Midwest Province. Our new province envisions a bright future: the novitiate is at maximum capacity for a second year, with a total of 93 men in formation, and this year 13 men are being ordained to the priesthood.

At the same time, the Jesuits — like others with aging relatives — face the challenge of caring for the largest number of senior Jesuits in our history; more than 100 senior Jesuits are receiving care. To meet their needs, the province is embarking on an essential \$25 million campaign, *With Others. For Others.*
