Nativity Preparatory School Selects Experienced Ignatian Educator as New Principal
Kyle Mullins to Lead Academic Program at the Tuition-Free, High-Achieving Jesuit Middle School

Jamaica Plain, MA (May 21, 2018) - Nativity Preparatory School is pleased to announce that Mr. Kyle Mullins will be joining the Faculty as Principal, effective for the 2018-2019 academic year. Hired after an extensive search and bringing years of Jesuit education experience, Mr. Mullins will oversee the extended-day, extended-year academic program of Nativity Prep.

Kyle joins Nativity Prep from Regis High School in New York City, NY, one of the country's highest-ranked high schools, where he served as Dean of Students overseeing 530 young men.

"Kyle has an extraordinary passion for Jesuit education coupled with a depth of administrative experience, making him an ideal educational leader for Nativity Prep. His work at both Regis High School and the REACH Program has prepared him well to carry on Nativity Prep's mission of transformative education."

Previously, Mr. Mullins held the dual role of a faculty member in the Regis English Department and Academic Dean and Summer Coordinator for REACH (Recruiting Excellence in Academics for Catholic High Schools), a 3-year educational and leadership program serving middle school students from mostly low-income immigrant families.

"Kyle Mullins is an Ignatian educator. As a college student, young teacher, and then administrator, he has practiced being a Catholic gentlemen of compassion, conscience, and competence. Kyle's departure from Regis is a loss, but I am excited by how and what he will be able to give to countless Nativity students in the coming years," said Fr. Mario Powell, SJ, director of the REACH Program and Nativity Prep Trustee.

Mr. Mullins earned a masters degree in English from Boston College in 2012 and his undergraduate degree from Le Moyne College (Syracuse, NY) in 2009, both Jesuit institutions.
